Project Description:

During the summer of 2005, Wieck Construction successfully managed the Life Safety & Fire Protection installation and upgrades to nine separate Vanderbilt University fraternity houses. To successfully complete a project of this magnitude in such a limited amount of time, the critical path required contracts be written with three separate fire sprinkler subcontractors. Each subcontractor was responsible for three fraternity houses. Phase I encompassed all site utility upgrades for Vanderbilt University's Greek Row community.
